



TCNJ Transfer Credit Fact Sheet

- TCNJ is on a 1 unit (4 credit) system.
- 3 credits in transfer equals .75 TCNJ units.
- 16 units (64 credits) is the transfer credit maximum from a two year institution.
- 20 units (80 credits) is the transfer credit maximum from a four year institution.
- Pre-Algebra, Algebra, Pre-Calculus or Reading courses will not be accepted in transfer. Pre-Calculus can be used to satisfy the prerequisite requirement for Calculus.
- Minimum grade of C is required to transfer a course.
- Courses and credits transfer, not the letter grade. Students will begin with a 0.00 GPA.
- Placement testing is required for all students wishing to transfer second language courses to TCNJ. (based on students' major).
- Students transferring with less than 8 units (32 credits) will be classified as a Freshman Level Transfer Student.
- Freshman Level Transfer Students will be required to complete all courses that our "first year" freshmen students are required to complete. Including the FSP course and the Civic Responsibilities.
- Students entering TCNJ with 8 units or more will not be required to complete the FSP course or any Civic Responsibilities at TCNJ
- Students earning an AA or AS degree from a New Jersey Community College will not be required to complete any liberal learning courses or Civic Responsibilities at TCNJ.
- Advanced Placement scores should be sent to TCNJ from Collegeboard to be evaluated based on TCNJ's standards. The AP Legend can be found at: <http://advisingresources.pages.tcnj.edu/test-credit/advanced-placement/>
- In some cases students will need to seek further evaluation of their credits from their department chairperson.
- All FINAL transcripts should be sent to the Office of Admissions.
